The Book

She started by taking the old lore and making it her own. *The Faewitch* has the old lore such as witches, faeries, and elves but adds a more modern twist to it. She thought it would be fun to mix up the original magic with a more modern magic, giving the characters even more power and maybe even evolving the story into something totally new. *The Faewitch* teens have to figure out how good can overcome evil while also living in the moment. They struggle through real life situations such as relationship problems, school, drinking, and sex. "By Writing these situations in the book, it is more relatable and believable.
